Popejoy Youth Concert - Call for Volunteers!

It's that time of year again! Thousands of fifth-grade school children will be taking over Popejoy Hall on the UNM campus for New Mexico Philharmonic performances and Music Guild volunteers have a long history of providing escorts for the APS students as they debark from their buses across the plaza into the concert hall. Volunteers will be stationed along the walking route from Johnson Field, where the students are dropped off, to the front doors of Popejoy Hall. Ushers will direct them from there to their assigned seats. Details include:

☐ Concerts for fifth-graders will be held on Tuesday, September 19, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon and Thursday, September 21, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon.



- ☐ The parking garage just east of Popejoy Hall is the most convenient parking, but it uses pay stations which accept credit cards only.
- ☐ Plan to be in the Popejoy Hall Donor's Lounge by 8:45.

Here's what to expect:

- ☐ There will be a rush of excited children.
- ☐ Two 45-minute performances both days at 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon.
- ☐ The buses begin to arrive about 9:00 a.m. for the 10:00 a.m. concert.
- Once the students are seated, the volunteers can relax and enjoy the concert.
- ☐ After the concert, the students are released by their schools.
- As the morning buses pull away, the 12:00 noon buses begin to arrive.
- J Volunteers can leave after the second wave of students have been seated.
- Wear comfortable shoes, sunscreen and a hat.

This is an excellent volunteer opportunity to renew acquaintances, as well as make new friends, AND attend a free concert...music is our future.
