### Music Guild of New Mexico's Jackie McGehee Young Artists' Competition

#### February 15, 2020 at Robertson & Sons

Did you know -- A concerto is a piece of music composed for an instrumental soloist and orchestra. It is written in a way to highlight the musical skills and expressiveness of a single musician, while being accompanied by an orchestra

We welcome young musicians ages 10 – 21 to participate in the Music Guild of New Mexico's Jackie McGehee Young Artists' Competition for Piano and Strings. The first-place winner in each category is awarded an opportunity to perform their concerto with the **NM Philharmonic**.

The rigorous competition application process requires an audition by the young artist with a 10-minute segment of a concerto from an approved repertoire list, a biographical profile, a teacher recommendation, a photograph, and a \$50.00 application fee. The Audition Committee reviews each application twice to determine if an applicant is eligible to participate. The application is now available on-line at **musicguildofnewmexico.org** 

We welcome all Guild members, teachers, students, families, and friends to enjoy these wonderful performances and share in the festivities of the day. It is an event not to be missed and one that makes us all proud of our future classical musicians.

# Grace Note 2019

A Grace note is a musical note that adds an embellishment to a musical selection, some call it an ornament.

In symphonic music, grace notes are used to help express the music's (and the composer's) intent. It is used in many genres of music in many different ways, and the music resulting from these effects are very expressive and moving.

In 1977 the Music Guild created the Grace Note Award in order to recognize a Guild member whose contribution of time and energy to the Guild is singularly outstanding. The criteria considered for awarding the Grace Note Award are longevity of service, variety of service and promotion of the Music Guild in the community.

This Year's Grace Note recipient is all of that and more. She is a long-time member of the Guild who has fully participated and served kindly and diligently.
